2. You may use the two-step, online registration or print and mail in your registration form. Remember to also book your meal packages and pre order your souvenir T-shirts and hats.
3. CanIRON XII Fees:

 - b. \$300 Full Conference after May 31, 2019.
 - c. \$125 Single Day Conference.

1. An area will be provided for Tailgate Sales.
2. No booth fee will be charged for Tailgate Sales.
3. Tailgate items include blacksmith tools, made or purchased, for sale by owner.
4. Owners staff their own sales area.
5. CanIRON XII declines all responsibility beyond offering free space for Tailgate Sales.

Conference Notes

1. Conference meal packages are available on the registration form until June 20, 2019.
2. Souvenir CanIRON XII T-shirts and hats are only available by pre order on your registration form.
3. Bring a lawn chair if you have room. Maybe an extra one for someone that flies in.
4. Individuals arriving from another country may want to quote the event name, website and location when entering Canada (in the unlikely case you are asked).
5. Out of country sellers may be subject to taxes/duties on their wares at the border. Reimbursement on unsold goods will likely be by mail.
6. Canada has much different and stricter gun laws than the United States. To speed and simplify border crossing, please leave all firearms at home.
7. BYOB. (And a thermal mug as glass moving around the site is discouraged.)

Safety Notes

8. Registrants acknowledge that forging metal and watching others forge metal can be hazardous.
9. Registrants to provide their own Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
10. CanIRON, the Saskatchewan Blacksmith Guild and Ness Core Ventures take no responsibility for your personal safety.
11. A basic first aid kit is on site.
12. Big River (15 minutes away) has a small hospital and ambulance service.

Ness Creek Site Notes

1. Free non-electrical camping for CanIRON registrants. No preregistration required.
2. An electrified campsite is \$27.50 per night. Access to electricity is \$15 per night. Electricity is limited. (No air conditioners, please.) Bring an extension cord.
3. No water or sewer hook-ups in the camping sites.
4. Cabins do not have running water or toilets.
5. Toilets located in three different public buildings on site.
6. Showers are coin operated, \$1 for two minutes.
7. Ness Creek has a sewage dump station, as does Big River.
8. Non-electric camping at Ness Creek is free to CanIRON registrants.
9. All electrified camping and cabin accommodations are to be booked via <https://discovernesscreek.com/>.
10. Ness Creek rental policies and pet information here <https://discovernesscreek.com/facilities/rates-policies/>.
11. Glass containers are discouraged but allowed at your cabin or campsite.
12. Camping sites and yurts rentals are also available at Nesslin Lake, 12 kilometers away. Book these via <https://nesslinlake.com/nesslin-lake/>.
13. All CanIRON guests must depart by noon on Monday, July 1, as this is the end of the rental agreement.
14. forestART (hands-on blacksmith classes) registrants are welcome to stay on site after CanIRON XII.
